

## **RISK FACTORS** PROTECTIVE FACTORS Chaotic home environment Strong family bonds Ineffective parenting Parental engagement in child's life Little mutual attachment and nurturing Clear parental expectations and consequences Inappropriate, shy, or aggressive classroom behavior Academic success Academic failure Strong bonds with pro-social institutions (school, community, church) Low academic aspirations Conventional norms Poor social coping skills about drugs and Affiliations with alcohol deviant peers Perceived external approval of drug use (peer, family, community) Parental substance abuse


## Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths United States, 1970-2007
